# **Our People**

We continued to promote an inclusive, diverse culture through our hiring practices, engagement programs, and Employee Resource Groups (ERGs).



In 2023, our representation of women increased among all groups, in technical, non-technical, manager and VP+ roles.



92% of U.S. open roles received at least one applicant from a demographic group that is underrepresented in the tech sector.

We listened to our employees, receiving more than 1,800 responses on our global Pulse Survey that will continue to inform our best-in-class employee programs.

With FlexBase, our global flexible workplace strategy, we empower employees, source a broad range of talent, and diversify our global footprint.

### **Communities**

Akamai employees gave back to communities, logging more than 6,700 volunteer hours



We institute the highest level of business ethics across our global operations. We provide robust training for our employees on our expectations and offer a third-party whistleblower hotline for anyone to report potential issues 24/7.

In partnership with <u>EcoVadis</u>, our Responsible Supply Chain Program helps us identify sustainability-related supplier risks and advance sustainability in our supply chain.
